In order to vote you must produce two pieces of acceptable identification to the election staff at the voting place. Please note that residents living on Westbank First Nations Reserves # 9 and #10 are not eligible to participate in the Mayor and Councillor election for the Westside District Municipality.

Resident Elector Qualifications (residents and dependants living within the Westside District Municipality):

- You are age 18 or older as of the date that you vote; AND
- You are a Canadian citizen; AND
- You have lived in British Columbia in the six months immediately preceding voting day; AND
- You have lived within the Westside District Municipality for at least 30 days immediately preceding voting day; AND
- You are not disqualified from voting or otherwise disqualified by law.

Non-Resident Property Elector Qualifications (owns property but does not live within the Westside District Municipality):

- You are NOT entitled to register as a resident elector of the Westside District Municipality; AND
- You are age 18 or older as of the date that you vote; AND
- You are a Canadian citizen; AND
- You have lived in British Columbia in the six months immediately preceding voting day; AND
- You are a registered owner of property within the Westside District Municipality for at least 30 days immediately preceding voting day; AND
- You have been authorized in writing by the other owner(s) of the property as the Non-Resident Property Elector for that property; AND
- You are not disqualified from voting or otherwise disqualified by law.

Non-resident property electors are required to obtain a "Certificate to Vote" prior to the time of voting or on voting day.

- You have lived in British Columbia in the six months immediately preceding voting day; AND
- You are a registered owner of property within the Central Okanagan West Electoral Area for at least 30 days immediately preceding voting day; AND
